

Gen Con 2020 Art Show Juried Submission Prospectus

This document applies to Gen Con Art Show

The Gen Con Art Show is the premiere industry showcase for artists in the fantasy, sci-fi, and gaming genres. Gen Con 2019 was another record-breaking year of turnstile attendance. The quality of our Art Show has made it a "must see" part of the Gen Con experience.

Applying to the Gen Con Art Show is an anonymous juried process. Any artist interested in applying will need to submit an entry to be reviewed by a jury.

Submission Period November 4 – November 17, 2019 **Jury Review** November 18 – December 8, 2019

Notification Date January 6, 2020 **Registration Deadline** January 19, 2020

PRICING

Submission Fee (non-refundable) \$25 **Two-Panel Table** \$490 **Four-Panel Table** \$655

- The cost of the table is for the entire four (4) days of the convention.
- There are two choices of tables: four-panel or two-panel. Tables are 23" wide, a two-panel table is 6' long, a four-panel table is 8' long. Tables are skirted.
- Half tables are not available. Sharing tables is prohibited.
- Table price includes two (2) "Exhibitor" badges, one for the Artist and one for an assistant.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- 1. Submissions are only accepted online through Entrythingy.com. Paper submissions will not be accepted.
- 2. You must have an account in entrythingy.com and gencon.com.
- 3. There is a submission fee of twenty-five (\$25) dollars. Fee is *non-refundable* whether or not artist is accepted into the Gen Con Art Show.

Artist must submit three (3) different pieces of their work including title, medium, and dimensions. Work submitted must represent the artwork Artist intends to show/sell at the Gen Con Art Show. Images should be of good quality and give the jurors a good idea of who you are.

- Do not include a water mark on your images; this is an anonymous jurying process and it detracts from the work.
- o Image upload sizes are: Max file size of 5MB; min file size of 100kb; min size width of 500px
- o Image file types accepted: jpg, gif, png
- 4. Artists will be notified either way.
- 5. Accepted artists will be required to fill out a registration form; form will be emailed along with their acceptance notification. The registration form must be filled out, signed, and returned along with full payment by the Registration Deadline date.
- 6. If artist's registration form is not received by the deadline date, artist will forfeit entry and will no longer be considered a participant of the art show.

GENERAL POLICIES (Please read the Appendix B: Rules & Regulations document for all the information)

- 7. All work must be the creation of the potential exhibiting artist and should relate to fantasy, science fiction, or the gaming industry.
- 8. Craft artists are prohibited. Craft art includes but is not limited to: jewelry, costume items, masks, ceramics, stained glass and toys.
- 9. Only the registered artist may sell the work; no retailers are permitted in the Art Show.
- 10. Attendance at Gen Con is required in order to display work/sell merchandise; Artist must be present and attend the show for all four days.
